# David A. Harkless Dies at Age of 91

## Death Leaves 10 Civil War Veterans in County.

Only 10 surviving Civil war veterans were left in Franklin county Friday, with the death Friday of David Andrew Harkless, age 91, com-

mander of J. C. McCoy Post No. 1, Grand Army of the Republic, at the residence of his daughter, Mrs. Lavada Margo, 1194 Oak street.

During the Civil war Mr. Harkless served as a member of the One Hundred and Forty-seventh regi-



ment, Indiana Volunteer infantry. He was active in G. A. R. affairs all of his life, and attended the recent annual state encampment of that organization in Columbus.

Mr. Harkless came to Columbus from Haydenville 40 years ago and was a cabinet-maker by trade. He was a member of the Presbyterian church and held membership with I. O. O. F. Lodge No. 262 in Logan.

### Funeral Monday

Funeral services will be held at 2 p. m. Monday at the Denton & Donaldson funeral home and interment will be made in Green Lawn.

Mr. Harkless leaves three daughters, four sons, 25 grandchildren and 19 great-grandchildren.
